Dear students and parents,

On **TUESDAY, MAY 15th** Mr. Craddock and Mr. Van Uden have planned a science field trip for all of the FLVT Science 7 students to Drumheller where they will attend the Royal Tyrrell Museum. Below is our itinerary for the day.

- 7:00 a.m. – Motor Coaches departs for Drumheller from FLVT
- 10:00 a.m. – Arrive at the Royal Tyrrell Museum and start our tour
- 12:00 p.m. – Meet together for lunch
- 2:15 p.m. – Departure from the Royal Tyrrell Museum for FLVT
- 5:15 p.m. – Motor Coaches arrive back at FLVT for student pick-up

This field trip is meant to be both enjoyable and educational. All of the students will be required to complete an assignment that relates to the Planet Earth unit that we are currently covering. This assignment is to be completed throughout the trip that day and those students that do not attend the field trip will be expected to complete an alternate assignment in school during the day we are absent.

The cost of the trip is **\$30** which covers the students' transportation to and from Drumheller, and their tickets to the Royal Tyrrell Museum. Students will require additional spending money for the concessions and lunch at the museum if they do not plan to bring a bag lunch. On the day of the trip, please make sure to check the weather and have your child dress appropriately. We will be spending the whole day in the museum and will only be going outside for a short 15 min. hike if weather permits. In the event of an emergency and you need to contact your child during this outing, you can call the school office staff at 403-381-0953 who will have the emergency cell phone numbers of the lead teachers going with the students.

We encourage parents to come along on the trip as chaperones free of charge but a current criminal record check must be completed and on file from the current school year. Forms are available at the school office and usually take a minimum of 3 weeks to process so don't wait.

If you would like your son/daughter to take part in this activity on Tuesday, May 15th, **THE ATTACHED FORM MUST BE FILLED OUT AND RETURNED WITH THE \$30 FEE PAID NO LATER THAN MONDAY, MAY 7TH** as arrangements need to be made in advance of our arrival date.
